## From the Principal's Desk

Our After School Care programme starts next week from the 5th March. Audrey, Keri-Lee and Lisa will be available to look after children until 6pm and have some exciting activities planned already!

For now, please leave messages with the office, including pick up times and whether or not we should feed the children.

Children who go home on the late bus will not be charged for after school care. Rates will be \$6 per hour, \$15 for the whole evening or \$60 per week. Afternoon tea will include a range of sandwich choices and pieces of fruit and will be served at 3.15pm (ish.) It is optional and will be charged at \$2 per meal.

We have listened to feedback from our community to start this programme, so please do take advantage of it. If it is well supported, we may be able to reduce rates in the future. If not, charges will go up or the service may need to be withdrawn.
